



ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

\$1,000 AWARD

APPLICATIONS DUE 5PM, March 22, 2019

The Ken-Caryl Ranch Foundation is soliciting applications for its annual academic scholarship for Ranch residents in their senior year in high school. This year, one student will be awarded \$1,000 to help defray the costs of higher education. The primary basis used to award this scholarship is **community service**.

To be eligible to receive this scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Submit a completed application form (which includes a **one-page essay on community service**) by the established deadline (5pm, March 22rd in the Ranch House);
2. Submit an OFFICIAL transcript as of the end of the first semester of his/her senior year in high school;
3. Submit a copy of acceptance letter from the accredited post-secondary institution he/she will be attending the semester following high school graduation;
4. Have been a Ken-Caryl Ranch resident for at least six months prior to submitting this application;
5. Have an overall high school grade point average of at least 3.0 (on a 4-point scale) as of the end of the first semester of his/her senior year in high school;
6. Not be related to any current Ken-Caryl Ranch Foundation Board member.

Application forms are available at the Ken-Caryl Ranch House, on the Ken-Caryl Ranch Foundation website (www.kencarylranhfoundation.org), and many of the local high school postgraduate centers.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to receive one of these scholarships, the applicant must:

1. Submit a completed application form by the established deadline (the application is to include a **one-page self-written** essay on community service which describes: 1. what the applicant thinks is meant by community service, and 2. his/her own contributions in the way of community service);
2. Submit an **OFFICIAL** transcript as of the end of the first semester of his/her senior year in high school;
3. Submit a copy of acceptance letter from the accredited post-secondary institution he/she will be attending the semester following high school graduation;
4. Have been a Ken-Caryl Ranch resident for at least six months prior to submitting this application;
5. Have an overall high school grade point average of at least 3.0 (on a 4-point scale) as of the end of the first semester of his/her senior year in high school;
6. Not be related to any current Ken-Caryl Ranch Foundation Board member.

Completion and submission of this application constitutes authorization for the Ken-Caryl Ranch Foundation to contact references and schools to verify the accuracy of the submitted information.
